NOMINATIONS DEADLINES (PARTNERS)

- **1st June 2024** Winter semester and whole academic year
- 1st November 2024 Summer semester

NOMINATION & APPLICATION STEP BY STEP

 Step I: Nomination
 Partner university nominates their students and sends their nomination via NCU form

Step II: Application

Nominated students have to register via <u>Online Application System</u> and complete the application

- Step III: Faculty coordinator accepts your LA Faculty coordinator verifies student's Learning Agreement and approves it or requests to make some changes
- Step IV: Sending the Invitation Letter Once the application is completed and Learning Agreement accepted by the Faculty Coordinator, an official Invitation Letter will be sent directly to the student

POLISH LANGUAGE COURSE
